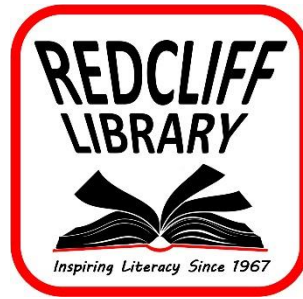

OVERVIEW

Here, at the Redcliff Public Library, we strive to support our community and 2019 was no exception.

This year saw the launch of our Bike Lending Program. The program, funded by the Community Foundation of Southeastern Alberta, involved the purchase of seven bikes for use by library members. This also earned us Shortgrass Library System's 2019 Best New Program Award.

We participated in School Safety Days, a partnership between local organizations such as Alberta Health Services, R.C.M.P., & Redcliff FCSS. Our role in this event was discussing internet safety with the children 12 & under in Redcliff. It was a great opportunity to connect with the students as we had some interesting discussions about this sensitive subject.

Our regular programming of Shake, Rattle, & Read; Summer Reading Program; Lego @ the Library; and Tween events were all well attended. For the adults, we offered programming with local authors and photographer, Chris Attrell.

- Acting as an inclusive and accessible community resource centre.

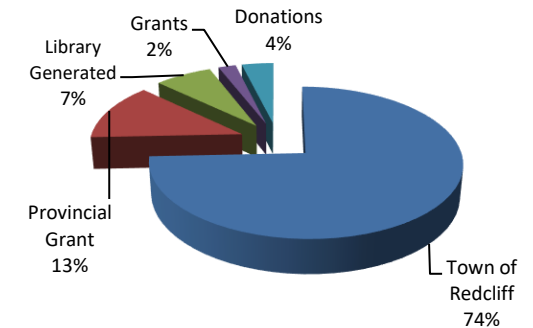
Plan of Service 2018 - 2022
